

**Information on Personal Data Protection at  
Agro Brokers Transport Sp. z o.o. Sp. K. of 16.05.2018.**

In compliance with Art. 13.1 and Art. 13.2 of the general regulation on personal data protection of 27 April 2016, I inform you as follows:

1. Your personal data is processed pursuant to Art. 6.1.a) or Art. 6.1.b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (hereinafter: GDPR).
2. The Controller is Agro Brokers Transport sp. z o.o. sp. k. ul. Krakowska 52, 50-425 Wrocław tel. +48 71/360 40 70, e-mail: [biuro@agrobrowsers.pl](mailto:biuro@agrobrowsers.pl).
3. The personal data disclosed to the Controller will be processed for the following purposes: to order and perform forwarding services, for contact needs, to be disclosed to other companies cooperating with the Controller solely with respect to contractual needs (sub-contractors, executors) and as specified in the contract or applicable laws.
4. The personal data may be disclosed to the extent required to perform carriage contracts concluded with the specific entity (in particular: the pick-up or delivery warehouse of the goods, counterparty, forwarder, broker) and in the process of commissioning certain operations to third parties by Agro Brokers Transport sp. z o.o. sp. K.: couriers, post office, law firms, accountants, etc.
5. Customers are free to disclose their personal data; however, when such data is not provided, orders cannot be executed.
6. The personal data will be processed for the time required to perform the contract, review potential claims by customers / counterparties / third persons and as required by applicable regulations (in particular with reference to accounting and storage of documents related to business operations).
7. The Controller shall be obliged to exercise due diligence to protect the interests of data subjects and comply with all the requirements set forth in the Act on personal data protection and in GDPR.
8. Data subjects shall have the right to be informed of processing operations, to access their data and the right to be forgotten, the right to revoke their consent, the right to have the processing restricted, the right to file complaints to the supervisory authority, to have the data corrected or deleted.
9. Persons who disclose their personal data for processing shall have the right to file complaints with the Data Protection Office when they find that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions of the Act on personal data protection and GDPR.
